Billy Walter Conner, known to his family and friends as Bill, 90 of Madisonville, TX; passed away on Wednesday; April 13, 2016 in Madisonville. A celebration of Bill's life is scheduled for 2PM on Saturday; April 23rd at The Midway Church of Christ with Bro. Lanier Stevens officiating. A visitation will be held prior to the service also at the church.

Bill was born on October 18, 1925 in Bennington, OK to Walter Clyde and Ina Rae (Coe) Conner Cox. He graduated from Bennington High School, took courses at Texas A&M University, and served his country with The United States Navy during World War II. Bill worked for Phillips Petroleum and retired after 34 years working in Oklahoma, Texas, and Norway. Upon retirement, he worked for The Texas Department of Criminal Justice for 10 years and was the owner of Bill Conner Insurance Agency for 20 years. Bill was active with the Midway Church of Christ, the Midway 4H Club, the Madison County Fair, and the Republican Party. He enjoyed being outdoors, hunting, fishing, bird watching, and a mean game of "42."

Bill was preceded in death by his parents and his wife of 48 years and mother of his children, Dovie Ann Jones Conner; his brother, Patrick Conner; his sister, Jimmie Mason; and his grandson, B.J. Zachary who died while serving The State of Texas as a trooper for The Texas Department of Public Safety.
