Casey Alton Bradshaw, a 5th generation Texan, was born on October 14, 1949 in Gorman, Texas to Mcoy Bradshaw and Berniece Elizabeth (Dean) Bradshaw. He spent his childhood in Comanche County, Texas and graduated from Sam Houston State University with a Bachelor's Degree in English and Spanish.

Casey served the State of Texas as a law enforcement officer for 51 years, beginning with his position as a police officer for the Abilene Police Department.

Casey lived a wonderful life of 75 years, 6 months, and 27 days.
