Retired Lieutenant Colonel David Hoyt Huffines, Jr. 88 of Midway, TX; passed away on Monday October 23, 2017 in Madisonville, TX surrounded by his family and friends. In addition, David worked in the oil and gas industry, received a Bachelor of Business and Education earning a permanent teaching certification, a real estate license, a pilot's license, started his own company, retired from the Internal Revenue Service, and retired again from Edwards County Sheriff's department.
