November 13, 1940 - July 25, 2014

James “Jimmy” Clarence Wells of Madisonville passed away Friday, July 25, 2014, at his home. He was born November 13, 1940, in Madisonville, Texas, and later a graduate of the class of 1959 from Madisonville High School. Shortly thereafter, he began his college career at Sam Houston State University playing football. However, he later graduated from Texas A&M University with a degree in animal husbandry and became a member of the Fightin’ Texas Aggie Class of 1964.

Jimmy was a life-long member of the First United Methodist Church in Madisonville, and he particularly enjoyed attending the Men’s Bible Class in later years.

Since 1977, Jimmy and Bobby Wise have owned and operated Madisonville Feed Center where he relished spending countless hours “getting educated” with his coffee-drinking friends. A very caring individual with a huge heart, Jimmy was quick to lend a helping hand to family and friends. He especially loved his family, ranching, Civil War history, and antique guns.

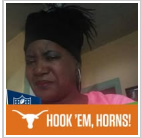
