



## Jo Ann (Snow) Williams

Jo Ann (Snow) Williams; 87 years; of Houston, TX; passed away on Wednesday; July 6, 2022 in Pasadena, TX. She loved attending church, singing gospel music, and correcting everyone's grammar. When not teaching, she had a passion for shopping for make-up and beautiful clothes and getting her hair done. Jo Ann was preceded in death by her husband; Robbie Carroll Williams; her parents Sarah Velma (Batson) Snow and Claude Randolph Snow; and her grandson Joseph Ryan Nedbalek.
