Five weeks after being such a blessing to our world, Krete Kyle Lucherk entered the hands of Jesus as he passed away peacefully in his parents arms at the Baylor Scott and White Hospital in Temple, Texas after being affected by an intestinal disease called necrotizing enterocolitis.

Krete was the first born twin on August 29, 2018 in College Station, Texas; fourteen weeks early, at 26 weeks gestation, weighing 2 pounds 3 ounces. He had begun to make great progress; been bathed by his mother and consoled by her presence, chance to cry, the opportunity to feel the touch of his twin brother Kourage, and know the love of his family as he was held in their arms, including big sister Kaisley. He too appeared perfect, had the slender frame of his father, thick hair, bright eyes, long fingers and according to sister Kaisley, "the perfect little feet". Krete touched numerous hearts and was loved by many. He passed away on October 6, 2018.

Krete is preceded in death by his twin brother, Kourage Valor Lucherk.
