Naomi Marcialine (Corley) Crouch; 85 years; a long-time resident of Madisonville; went home to be with the Lord on Saturday; January 3, 2026 in The Woodlands. Funeral services are scheduled for 10AM on Saturday; January 10, 2026 at Bedias Baptist Church with Bro. Paul Brantner officiating. The burial will follow at Bedias Baptist Cemetery. The visitation is scheduled to begin at 9AM prior to the service.
