Wayne Rudy Mikeska, 75, passed away Saturday, October 21, 2017 in Houston, TX. Funeral services are scheduled for 2:00PM Thursday, October 26th the Day Funeral Home Chapel in Madisonville, TX with the burial to follow at the Madisonville City Cemetery. Wayne was both courageous and overly generous and he provided help and assistance to those in need. He will be greatly missed and remembered by his family and friends as the most noble of men.
